Call it a semiguincentennial; call it Bicenquinquagenary or call it America250--- just help us celebrate it!



t was November 1778. The wind and snow were deepening as the American soldiers began their work on a Fort to be built 240 feet by 240 feet and to be named Fort Laurens. Not the perfect time to be building a fort especially since the war had been going on for three years and parts of the Declaration of Independence had already been drafted and signed. But communication was slow and the Continental Congress was assuming more responsibility for military activities in the Ohio Country and Fort Laurens was to be a steppingstone on the march to Detroit. Today, the Fort Laurens Museum contains artifacts from previous excavations and soon visitors will see more archaeology by the Ohio History Connection as we work to rebuild the fort in anticipation of the nation's semiguincentennial in 2026-a few short years away.

Around the same time, Schoenbrunn Village (Beautiful Spring), a Moravian missionary town, was under the Christian leadership of Moravian Missionary David Zeisberger. Founded in 1772, its location and close proximity to what was to become Fort





Laurens put the neutrality of the Christians in the middle of the Revolutionary War.

Today, Schoenbrunn Village in New Philadelphia is reconstructed to appear at it did over 250 years ago consisting of 18 log buildings, the original cemetery and 2 1/2 acres of planted fields. Due to Zeisberger's records, all the structures are built on the exact spot they were those many years ago.

Just as the war was ending and while sympathies for both sides ran high, the brutal massacre of over 90 Christian Indians occurred in the missionary town known as Gnadenhutten which was just a few miles from Schoenbrunn Village. A monument, museum, mass grave and two reconstructed log buildings stand today to commemorate this tragic event. The story of David Zeisberger, Schoenbrunn Village, Gnadenhutten and Fort Laurens is relived summer nights at the Schoenbrunn Amphitheatre near where this historic action took place, with the production of *Trumpet* in the Land-Ohio's official State Play. Experience history come to life under the stars!

History Abounds!

Visit Ohio's first school or explore 'Dreamsville' and the **Dennison Railroad Depot Museum** --- a National Historic Landmark and a famous World War II stop. Annually hosting Ohio's ONLY **Polar Express Train ride** to the North Pole, your family won't want to miss this museum and its events.

The **Ernest Warther Museum** will amaze you with its 64 one of a kind, hand carved to scale models of some of the most influential moments in train history. Visit with 'Mrs. Warther' as she takes you on a tour of her button house which today is home to over 73,000 buttons.

If you want to see full size trains the **Age of Steam Roundhouse** is where you'll want to be. Twenty-two (22) steam and five diesel locomotives are housed at this actual railroad repair shop, museum, and roundhouse.

A Rauch and Lang electric car sits in juxtaposition to glass slippers at the **Reeves Victorian Home and Museum**. The size of the home (17 to 21 rooms, depending on how one counts pantries, bathrooms and storage areas) and its gleaming white exterior are enhanced by dormers, bays, turrets, classical columns and a porte cochere. Particularly beautiful at Christmas, the elegant home and museum are a testament to a former steel manufacturer's commitment to his community.






